
# Central SC Habitat for Humanity's Annual Report

2015-2016 A Year in Review









- 7 homes closed this fiscal year
- 17 children moved into safe and healthy homes with their families
- 75 individuals received financial counseling
- 23 individuals utilized the Wills Clinic
- 12 families paid off their mortgages (homes built 1995-1998)
- \$1,680,000 impact to local economy through all of our programs
- 252 homes have been completed since 1985



- Veteran Repairs (3.13%)




### \*Definition of all NR Programs\*


- Community Cleanups: clean sweeps of the surrounding neighborhoods where we are building.
- Home Preservation (ABWK): small exterior beautification and small repair projects on homes in the surrounding neighborhoods where we are building.
- Disaster Relief: cleanups in surrounding neighborhoods where disaster struck and repairs to homes.
- Veteran Repairs: aid in creating healthier, safer home environments through critical repairs and improvements.

# of Volunteer Hours (Habitat ReStore & Build Site)




